1. To consider accepting apologies for absence

2. To consider any declaration of interest

No declarations of interest were received

3. To approve the minutes of the meeting held on 10th September 2025

It was resolved to accept the minutes of the last meeting as a true record, and it was signed by the Chairman.

4. To receive any brief updates from County and District Councillor

County Cllr Kiddle-Morris' full report can be found on the website. It was confirmed that Norfolk County Council have agreed to the Devolution deal and Norfolk will be merging with Suffolk. The County Council election will still take place in May 2026 and the nominated Councillor will stand for a year due to the changes that will take place after a mayor is elected.

5. Open Forum for Public Participation: an opportunity to hear from members of the public

Parishioner requested an update on the refurbishment of the wooden village sign. The clerk is still chasing for a response from a local resident. The second fingerpost is now being refurbished.

6. To report and update on highways

Due to two recent accidents on the B1146, the Council will continue to push for a speed reduction to 40mph. County Cllr Kiddle-Morris confirmed that the gateway is now with the designers and highways have approved the site for the location. The Council feels that once this is in place that this will still not slow down vehicles.

7. To discuss and comment on the Local Plan

The Council discussed this at length, the most impact with be within the Litcham area. The Council will submit a no comment as it doesn't directly impact Horningtoft.

8.1 To receive planning applications from Breckland District

PL/2025/1642/HOU- Orchard House, Oxwick Road-Demolition of existing single-storey rear extension and detached outbuilding. Erection of a side extension and two-storey rear extension plus garage building to the front and detached outbuilding to the rear. The Council agreed to submit - no objections.
